

## Adults at the Party

### ***IF YOU WANT THE KIDS TO HAVE MORE FUN GET THE MUM'S TO DUMP AND RUN!***

The other parents are welcome to watch the show, (and join in the Party Dances) they will enjoy it, however you want your Child's party to be the best ever, and in my experience to achieve this it's best not to encourage the parents to stay at the party, a drop off and go policy is always best.

If the parents stay it leads to a whole host of additional problems, and extra work for you: -

#### **1/ Some Adults that stay won't want to watch and enjoy the show, they'd rather chat**

Parental Chatter is the number one major problem entertainers encounter, although most parents take an interest in their child and love to watch them having fun, some however would rather chat and don't consider the enjoyment of the others around them.

My priority at the party is for your child and his/her friends to have a fantastic time. So to stop these talkers spoiling the show for the children and those adults that do want to watch the fun, have a separate room available for the talkers to use. They can then chat away to their hearts content and not ruin the show for everyone around them.

#### **2/ Children whose parents stay often won't join in the party.**

The next time you go to a party watch how many kids don't join in, they'll all have something in common, a parent has stayed with them.

Even if they're not usually shy they'll stand by Mum or Dad and it can take an entertainer, (Even one as good and experienced as Mr. Wishy Washy), quite a while to entice them away from their parents side. Some kids will never join in the fun and spend the whole party next to their parent.

If the parents go within 5 minutes these kids will normally join in with their friends and have lots of fun.

#### **3/ Parents will take up space in the party room**

You'll also have the additional work of being hostess and supplying them with tea and coffee. You'll then miss out on a lot of the fun yourself, and may even miss your child's moment of stardom when they perform with Mr. Wishy Washy.

#### **4/ They may bring extra uninvited guests in the form of siblings of an invited child**

They have to come because Mum's staying, but to be honest this is a bit cheeky as they haven't been invited and you'll feel obligated to feed them and give them a party bag.
